Current Summer or Fall Applicants do NOT need to complete this form – they should apply by checking "yes" to the fellowship consideration question on the admission application and uploading the required essay as an attachment.

DEADLINE MARCH 10 (late applications will not be reviewed)

The School of Graduate Studies awards 12-20 Fellowships each academic year to outstanding full-time degree-seeking students. There are two levels of fellowship available for continuing, enrolled students. The suggested minimum criteria for consideration are listed below.

Provost's Fellowships:

- Unconditional admission to a graduate degree program at Appalachian.
- Full-time status (minimum enrollment in 9 graduate credit hours per semester).
- ***New students: A GPA in all college degrees of at least 3.5; Continuing (enrolled) students: A 3.7 GPA.***
- Standardized entrance test scores at or above the 60th percentile.

Fellowship funding is considered financial aid (not salary) and will be credited to the student account in two installments, one each semester, fall and spring, provided the student continues to meet the conditions of the award.

These Fellowships are not automatically renewable but a recipient may reapply and compete for a new award next year.
